Welcome to Youth Sailing @ Chasewater

Youth Sailing @ Chasewater is a registered Charity offering a fun and friendly way for youngsters (ages 10-18) to sail, whether learning from scratch or improving existing skills.

We offer a full training programme, run by RYA qualified instructors, which sees absolute beginners sailing solo in as little as two sessions, if they feel confident enough to do so.

Running Saturday mornings from Easter to mid-October, our fleet of boats range from one-man Toppers, Picos and Lasers through to two-man Miracles and multiple-crew Wayfarers, providing a variety of sailing experiences.

This activity is fully supervised by RYA qualified instructors with safety facilities provided at all times.

It's a great way for young people to be introduced to sailing and gain RYA qualifications.

Equipment/Clothing

We will provide each young person sailing with a Buoyancy aid. We advise you to wear either a wetsuit if you have one or an old T Shirt, fleece or jumper, trousers that are quick drying (i.e. not jeans or trackies) and trainers/pumps which will be worn at all times afloat. Also in case of rain a cagoule/waterproof top & trousers.

We strongly suggest a second set of dry clothing and footwear is brought, due to the likelihood of getting "wet" at some point during the session. There are showers to warm up & have a wash after the session so a towel is also advisable.

Food

Most Saturdays there is the opportunity to purchase food and drink from the Galley,
